How to Disable Automatic Dial-Up

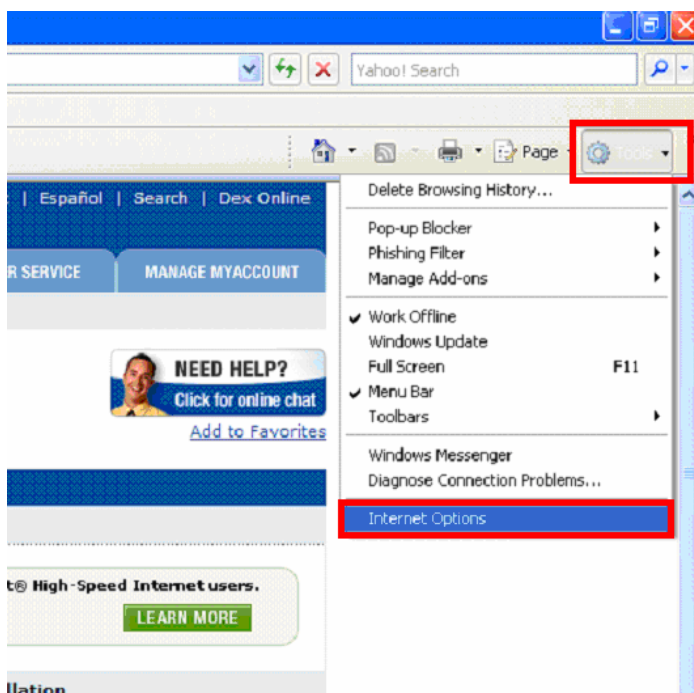
Use this document if:

- You want to disable the Automatic Dial-Up feature in Microsoft® Internet Explorer 7 (IE7).
 - When you transition from dial-up to high-speed Internet service, your computer may not recognize the high-speed connection, and continue to try to establish a dial-up connection automatically.
 - If you disable the Automatic Dial-Up feature, your computer should be able recognize your high-speed Internet connection and connect to that as the default.

This document assumes:

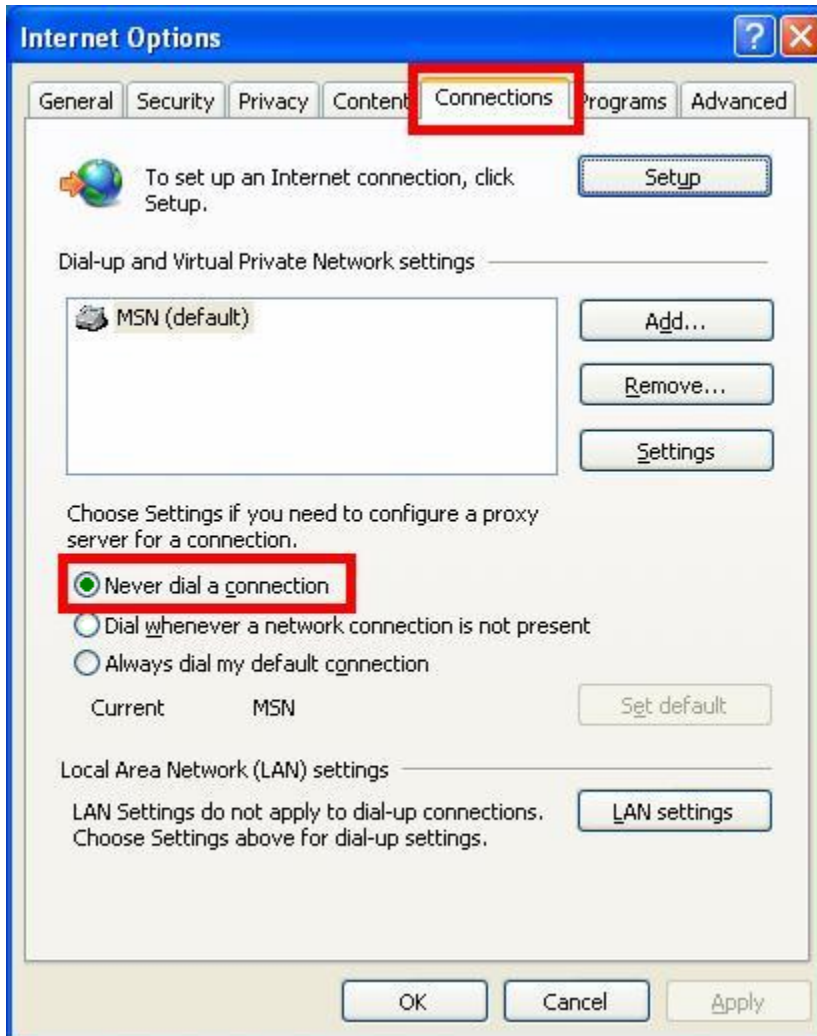
- You have IE7 installed and are using it.
- You are connected to the Internet, using a non-dial-up connection.

1. Open **Internet Explorer 7**.
2. In the Windows Taskbar, select **Tools**. Then, select **Internet Options**.



3. Select the **Connections** tab. Then, select **Never dial a connection**.

Note: If you are using Qwest® Broadband but wish to retain your dial-up connection as an alternate connection, do not delete the connection listed under Dial-up and Virtual Private Network Settings.



4. On the “Internet Options” page, select **Apply**. Then, select **OK**.
