



Cisco® 675 and 678 Modems

How to Install the Cisco Commander Software Updates Version 1.4.2

Macintosh®

1. An automatic search will locate your modem. The search and download will take up to 5 minutes. Don't continue until prompted.
2. Type your password, then select **Continue**.
3. Select **Update**. Don't interrupt the download process, or your modem could be disabled.
4. Select **Continue**. The modem will reboot. This could take up to 3 minutes.
5. Select **OK**.
6. Select **OK** again.
7. Select **Continue**.
8. Select **Save**.
9. Select **Quit**.
10. Reconnect the high-speed Internet line to the "wall" port on the back of the modem. Reset any other configuration changes you've made. This includes reinstalling hardware and software firewalls.
11. Double-click on the **Cmdr-Mac-1.4.2_noAR** folder on the desktop.
12. Double-click on the **Commander 1.4.2** icon.
13. Select **OK**.
14. Type your password. If you don't have a password, leave the field blank and select **OK**.
15. If the modem isn't trained, select the **Open Connection** bar. (The modem is trained if the "Connection State" field says "Opened.")
