



**Qwest® Advanced Networking Modem with Wireless:  
2Wire® 2700 HG**

**How to Connect to Wireless Network  
Mac OS® X**

To use the Qwest® Advanced Networking Modem with Wireless: 2Wire® 2700 HG with a Macintosh® computer, the Apple® Airport Card must be the only installed wireless adapter connected to your wireless gateway and Mac OS® X system.

Configure the Apple Airport card properly for Mac OS 10.1 through 10.3:

1. From the "Apple" Menu, choose **System Preferences**. Then, select **Network**.
2. Choose **New Location** from the "Network" drop-down menu.
3. Type the new location as **2Wire Wireless**.
4. Select **Airport** from the "Show" drop-down menu.
5. On the "TCP/IP" tab, set the **Configure** option to **DCHP**.
6. Select **Apply Now**.
7. Locate the wireless symbol in the options in the upper right corner of the screen, near the clock.
8. Select **2WIRExxx**.
9. A "WEP Password" appears. Change the **WEP Password** to the appropriate encryption type, usually a 40-bit hex.
10. If necessary, select **Add to Keychain**. Then, choose **Connect**.
