How to Allow Windows® Mail to Send Attachments

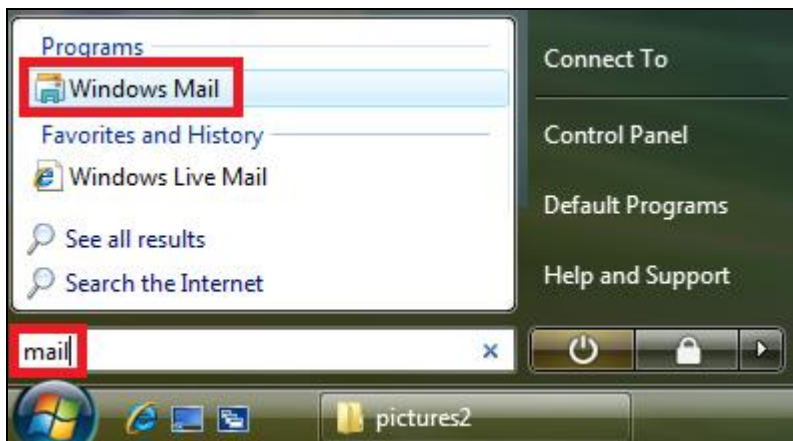
Use this document if:

You use Windows® Mail on the Windows Vista™ platform and you're having trouble sending e-mail attachments in the Windows Mail program.

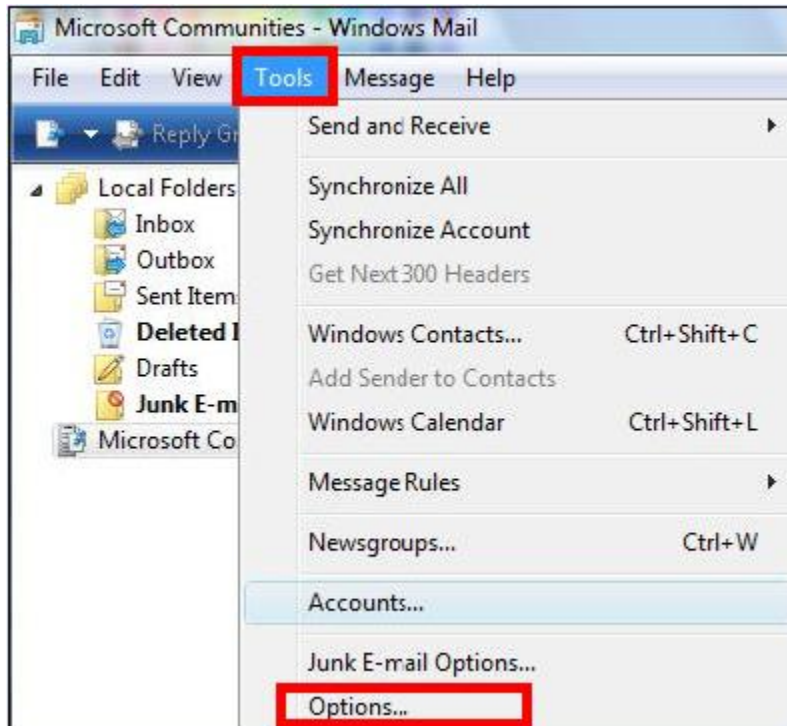
This document assumes:

- You are a Windows Vista user.
- You use Windows Mail to send and receive e-mail.
- You have an Internet connection.

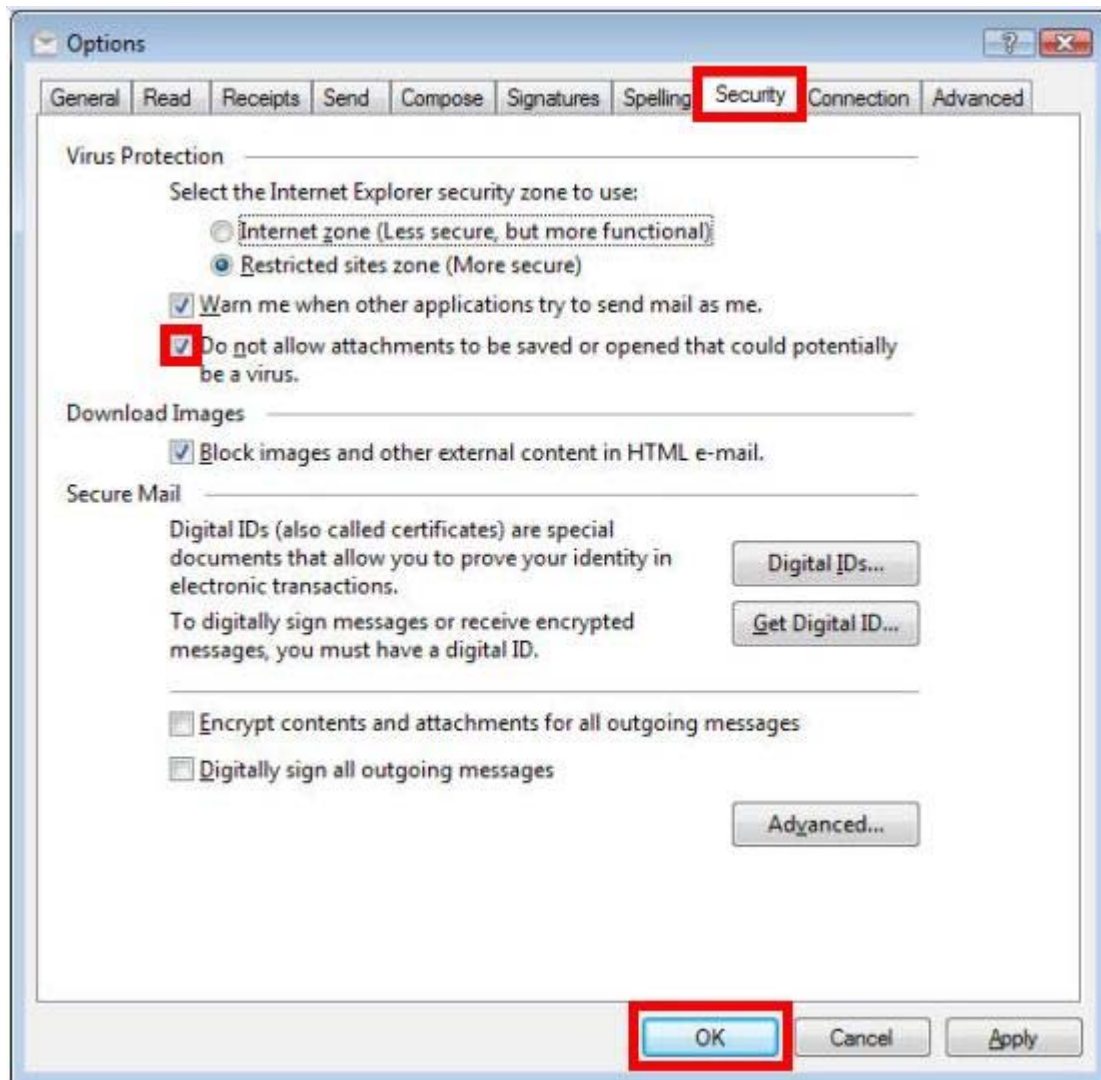
1. Click on the Windows **Start** button. Type "mail" in the search bar. Select **Windows Mail** when it appears in the programs list.



2. Select **Tools** at the top of the screen. Then, select **Options**.



3. Select the **Security** tab at the top of the screen. Uncheck **Do not allow attachments to be saved or opened that could potentially be a virus**. Select **OK** to exit the Options window.
