

# CALLER ID

*Caller ID lets you know who's calling before you pick up the phone. The Caller ID display shows the name and number of the person calling and remembers who's called you recently. With Caller ID, you can return important calls when you have time, or simply ignore calls you don't want.*

## USING CALLER ID

- When someone calls, a display attached to your phone shows the name and number of most callers after the first ring.
- The name and number of a caller is automatically stored in memory, even if you're not there to answer.
- If you see UNKNOWN, UNAVAILABLE or OUT OF AREA, the person is calling from an area where Caller ID is not available.
- If you see PRIVATE or ANONYMOUS on your Caller ID unit, it means that caller has chosen to block his/her line. You can reject these calls with Anonymous Call rejection, which is free with Caller ID.

Available in most areas. Compatible display unit required. Not all calls will display a number and/or name.
